- Approves expenses prior to submission to the Treasurer for payment

- Will assume all duties of the President should the President be absent or fail to act according to the requirements of the office of the President.
- Presides over the Winter Blast Planning Committee and act as meet coordinator if one is not appointed by the board

- Publish notice of ABC, Inc. meetings
- Record and publish meeting minutes
- Keeper of all ABC, Inc. records
- Approves expenses prior to submission to the Treasurer for payment

- Maintain banks and bookkeeping records for ABC, Inc.
- Renders a monthly accounting of the transactions and the financial condition of ABC, Inc.
- Will disseminate funds according to budgeted expenses, or as authorized by the Board.
- Will make all deposits and withdrawals for meets, fundraisers and other team related expenses.

Kelly Eisenbraun, Fundraising Director (ph: 763-756-4846)

- Oversees all activities relating to fundraising for the Booster Club
- Schedules adequate fundraisers to meet competitive season expenses
- Manages the progress of fundraisers to ensure that established guidelines are followed.
- Provides a full accounting to the Treasurer for each fundraiser in a timely manner
- Approves all expenses related to fundraising prior to submission to the Treasurer for payment
- Recruits volunteer to lead fundraisers

- Acts as a gym liaison between, team level representatives, ABC Board and gym management/coaches.

- Publish ABC newsletter
- Manages ABC website

- Notify local media outlets of meet results whenever applicable and update members on the progress of competitive teams and events at the gym
